CONTACT YOUR PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIAN

For non-emergency care, contact your primary care physician to schedule an appointment. Depending on your physician, virtual care from your mobile device or computer may be an option. If your primary care physician is not available:

Option 1 | CONTACT A MEMBER ADVOCATE

Contact a Member Advocate Monday through Friday 8:30 AM – 5 PM by calling the number on the back of your member ID card. When you need care, Member Advocates can help determine your options.

Option 2 | CALL THE FREE NURSE ADVICE LINE

Contact a licensed nurse 24/7 for support or questions by calling (844) 834-4375.

Option 3 | VISIT THE EXPRESS APPOINTMENT CENTER

Schedule a same-day appointment with the Express Appointment Center by calling **(614) 788-2730**. The Express Appointment Center offers the same services as your OhioHealth primary care office from minor illnesses and injuries to the routine management of chronic health conditions.

Option 4 | SCHEDULE A VIRTUAL CARE VISIT

Schedule a virtual visit with Teladoc through the convenience of your mobile device or computer. Teladoc is a national network of on-demand providers offering 24/7 access to board-certified physicians. Download the Teladoc Mobile App or visit Teladoc.com to get started.


